

WeProtect Global Alliance Board Meeting

Summary, June 2024

The WeProtect Global Alliance Board met on 11 and 11 June 2024.

Key Actions Agreed

- <u>Secretariat:</u> Board members were updated on the progress of project planning for the 2024 Global Summit and expressed desire to see child and survivor participation and the need to launch concrete objectives at the Summit. The Head of Communications presented on the Alliance's participation future programme and the Board underscored sustainability in participation efforts, existing successful engagement models were discussed as examples to follow.
- <u>Legislative Trends</u>: Board members were updated on recent legislative initiatives affecting tech platforms, specifically addressing challenges related to end-to-end encryption and regulatory developments globally.
- Policy and Government Affairs: The UK Home Office provided an update on the Five Country Working Group's Voluntary Principles to Tackle Child Sexual Exploitation and Abuse, highlighting diverse engagement since 2020 and outlining future steps.

A response timeframe was set for August to facilitate briefings for ministers' meetings in early September in Australia.

 Financial: Full funding for 2024 had been successfully secured. It was agreed that the Secretariat develop and share collateral materials to support funding approaches and explore avenues for engagement in collaboration with the Board.
